

What does my child's SafetyNET record look like?


Every child from 0 to 19 years old in Sheffield has a record on the SafetyNET system. This is what your child's record looks like (this child's record is made up):

What information is shown?

- 1 Your child's personal details are their name, address, gender, date of birth, school and GP. **No other personal details are held on the system.**
- 2 If someone is providing support for your child, e.g. from the Health Service, School, Social Services, Sure Start or a Voluntary Organisation, they can add their contact details here. **None of their work records are held on the system.**
-  If a worker has completed a Common Assessment with you and your child the CAF logo is shown next to the details of that worker. **No details of the Common Assessment are held on the system.**
- 4 If your child has previously had a Common Assessment, the details of the worker who completed this with you are shown here.
- 5 The source data shows where your child's personal details have come from. This could be the Social Care, Education or Health databases.

SafetyNET allows staff supporting your child to contact each other more easily. It isn't a case management system and it does not contain any other personal information about any child.
