

## Homework in Key Stage One

### What homework will my child have?

Children in Year One and Two will be sent a 'homework menu' and a book in which to complete their work where appropriate. They will also be sent weekly spellings and have a home/school reading book. Children in Year Two may also have a comprehension book with tasks to support their reading.

Children should choose one activity from the menu each week. Children will collect stamps on the class chart; one per week. Children who complete a weekly activity will be awarded a certificate at the end of the half term.

### How much homework are they expected to do?

- Weekly spellings
- Reading **or** reading comprehension activities three times a week. This should be only 5 or 10 minutes
- One task from the 'Homework Menu'

### Why do work at home?

- The children want you to be interested and involved in what they are learning
- Parents and Carers have asked to be involved in what the children are learning
- Children achieve better when their learning is supported at home
