

Waterthorpe Kid's Club Information Booklet

Who can come to the club?

All children attending Waterthorpe Nursery Infant School (nursery or school) and Emmanuel Junior School are welcome to attend Waterthorpe Kid's Club.

You can book places on a day to day or a weekly basis.

If you find that you need a place at short notice the club will do its best to accommodate you. Please try to give us as much notice as possible though.

What are the opening times of the club?

We are open every day from 3p.m. to 6p.m. Children can be collected at any time up to 6p.m. In the unlikely event that you find you will be late to collect your child please contact the club immediately on 0114 2473123. (We do have a late collection charge of £7 per 15 minutes where this happens more than once.)

How much does it cost?

If you sign a booking agreement to book places each month then the cost of a session is £8.50. If you are booking places on an occasional basis, without a booking contract, the cost of a place is £9. All places must be paid for in advance. There is also an initial £2 registration fee per family.

What if I need to cancel?

If you give 7-day's notice of cancellation you will receive a refund on your child's place. If your child is ill we will also give a refund of half the cost of their place.

Do the children get anything to eat?

Each evening the children are given a substantial snack. For example this may be pizza, beans on toast or noodles. There is also fresh fruit, milk and water available.

How do the children get to the club?

Teachers are told which children are going to the club.

- Children from the Nursery and Infants are collected from their classrooms at the end of the school day by the Play workers.
- Children from the Juniors are deemed responsible to make their own way through the school to Kid's Club. They are reminded at afternoon register if they are to go to Kid's Club. If you wish for your child to be collected from class this can be arranged.

How do I book a place?

You can book a place at the Waterthorpe Nursery Infant School office (Tel: 2484943) or phone Sue Moore/Kezia Willis on 0114 2473123.

Please note that some nights are very popular and quickly get booked up. It is advised that you check with the club and make a block booking for the nights of your choice in advance.

Who runs Kid's Club?

Kid's Club is a charitable organisation that is run by a management board. Representatives from Waterthorpe

NI School and Emmanuel Junior School sit on the board along with Kid's Club staff members.




What if my child has medical needs?

We are happy to support children with any medical needs and to give necessary medication. A medication form must be completed by parents/carers. All Kid's Club staff have had First Aid training.
