Attendance

It is extremely important that children arrive on time. We have a reduced number of staff in school and do not have the capacity to go to the gate, to collect children who arrive late.

We are working hard to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus, therefore children will need to come into school by themselves. Staff can not help by carrying reluctant children into school. If children are upset at the gate, parents may need to take them home and return later.

If your child will not be attending for a planned session, please could you let us know.

If your circumstances change, for example you are furloughed or are able to work from home, please could you let us know. Children of key workers should only attend school when there is no one at home to provide care.

Illness

Children who are unwell, should not attend school.

Anyone who has coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, such as a raised temperature, a new continuous cough, or a loss of or change to their sense of smell or taste, should stay at home. They should not attend an out-of-school setting and should follow the [guidance for households with possible coronavirus \(COVID-19\) infection](#) and get a test.

Please do not send your child to school if they have been given Calpol (paracetamol) as this may mask symptoms.

If your child becomes unwell while at a school, we will call you immediately to come and collect them.

If your child tests negative, they can usually return to school as soon as they are well.

If your child tests positive, [NHS Test and Trace](#) will speak directly to those that have been in contact with your child to offer advice.

Dinners

Hot dinners will still be provided in school. Children can continue to choose from the regular menu or bring their own packed lunch.

Wrap Around Care

After school club is closed.

Breakfast club will remain open for children in school. Please book your place in advance as normal through the school office.
